Pies:

- Pie filling and crust must be homemade
- OPEN TO ALL AGES, NO ENTRY FEE.
- The person running the Pie Baking Contest will have the final say on acceptability of pies
- Complete the registration form Entered pies become the property of the Heritage Festival and that you do not get your pie or pie pan back
- If you are a winner, you give your permission to have your photo taken during the announcement ceremony and have it used for Heritage Festival promotional materials
- All contest entries must provide a recipe for their pie (s)
- You may enter up to one pie per category.

Judging:

- Judging will be held Friday, Oct. 4th at 12:30 pm
- Criteria: Overall appearance, Crust, and Taste

Disposition of Pies:

- Any pies that are not pre-sold, will be sold on Facebook at 2 pm Fri. Oct 4th. Pies will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Whole pies minus the slice for judging will be sold.
- All proceeds from the sale of pies will be used by the Union Co. FCE programs to fund its many activities and services.
- Grand Prize Pie will be sold for \$25, 1st place pies will be sold for \$15, and all others will be sold for \$10.
