Classes

EGGS

- Entries should be fresh and clean, but not washed. Eggs should be presented in a fresh egg carton.
- Judging will be on uniformity of eggs, egg shape, shell texture and thickness, free from defects and absence of ridges or abnormalities.
 - o White Eggs (one dozen)
 - o Brown Eggs (one dozen)
 - Blue/Green eggs (one dozen)
 - Any other variety eggs (duck, goose, quail, etc)

GOURDS

All gourds must be grown by individual contestants. Gourds of all shapes and sizes accepted. May be a fresh grown gourd or dried and decorated.

PUMPKINS

All pumpkins must be grown by the exhibitor.

- Small Pumpkins less than 6 inches in diameter
- <u>Large Pumpkins</u> greater than 6 inches in diameter

BARN QUILT DESIGN

Get creative and make your own barn quilt design. This can be on a canvas, stitched together with fabric, or even made out of construction paper or other materials you can think of. These should <u>not</u> be the size of an actual barn quilt, any reasonable size is acceptable.

CANNING

Product must be in standard, clear glass canning jars with the name of the product on each jar. Each exhibit must be the work of the individual contestant. Mark the name of the exhibitor on the bottom of each jar.

- <u>Fruits and Vegetables</u>-apples, beets, peaches, green beans, tomatoes, peas, shelly beans, soup mixture, fruit juices, vegetable juices, other vegetables, other fruits
- Pickles- beet pickles, dill cucumber pickles, sweet cucumber pickles, pickles relish, other pickles
- Jams, Jellies, and Preserves- light jelly, dark jelly, preserves, jams, butters, any other jellied product

SEWING AND NEEDLE ART

- <u>Sewing & Needle Arts</u> Apron, pillowcase, stuffed animal, tote bag, clothing separates, clothing accessories, any other sewing, weaving such as basket or potholder, knitting, crochet, cross stitch
- 4-H or <u>UT theme craft</u>

FALL CENTERPIECE

Centerpieces must be made by exhibitor, can contain purchased items to create the piece such as flowers, leaves, pinecones, vases, etc.
